DR. MANDY WARTHAN

Dr. Mandy is board-certified in dermatology and dermatopathology. Fewer than three percent of dermatologists become dermatopathologists. Dermatopathology is focused on the microscopic diagnosis of skin cancers and moles. She is the only female dermatopathologist in McKinney. Dr. Mandy graduated from Southern Methodist University and completed medical school at the University

> of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston. She then completed a fellowship in dermatopathology at UT Southwestern in Dallas and her residency at Medical college of Georgia before opening Warthan Dermatology in 2010.

DR. MOLLY WARTHAN

Dr. Molly also graduated from Southern Methodist University and went to medi-

cal school at the University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston. She received her fellowship training in Mohs micrographic surgery in Tallahassee, Florida and her residency at Eastern Virginia Medical School. She is board-certified in dermatology and fellowship-trained in Mohs surgery, a specialized type of skin cancer surgery that is mainly used for skin cancers on the head and neck and recurrent, complicated skin cancers. She is the only fellowship-trained Mohs surgeon in McKinney.
