And, what is even more impressive is that they are the only sisters in the country practicing together as both a dermatopathologist, which is Dr. Mandy's specialty and a Mohs micrographic skin cancer surgeon, which is Dr. Molly's specialty. Both sisters graduated from Southern Methodist University and completed medical school and internships at the University of Texas Medical Branch in Galveston. Dr. Mandy completed her dermatology residency at the Medical College of Georgia and a fellowship in dermatopathology at UT Southwestern in Dallas. Dr. Molly completed her dermatology residency at Eastern Virginia Medical School and a fellowship in Mohs micrographic surgery in Tallahassee, Florida.

Dr. Mandy Warthan is board certified in dermatology and dermatopathology. Fewer than three percent of dermatologists become dermapathotopologists. Dermatopathology is focused on the microscopic diagnosis of skin cancers and moles. Dr. Mandy is the only female dermatopathologist in McKinney.

Dr. Molly Warthan is board certified in dermatology and fellowshiptrained in Mohs surgery. Mohs micrographic surgery is a specialized type of skin cancer surgery that is used mainly for skin cancers on the head and neck and recurrent, complicated skin cancers. During her fellowship, Dr. Molly performed over 1,000 Mohs surgeries, including training in surgical reconstruction on the head and neck by a plastic surgeon. She is the only fellowship-trained Mohs surgeon in McKinney.

Both doctors have participated in dermatology research and been published extensively in academic journals. They have been quoted in *The New York Times* and Dr. Molly had a scheduled appearance on the NBC *Today Show*.

Warthan Dermatology treats skin diseases in patients of all ages including children, adults and seniors.
